**Lake Update:** Treatment of some areas of lily pads and many areas of bulrush was performed mid-September of 2018. The first lake treatment for 2019 is planned for early to mid-June as long as weeds have grown enough to provide an effective weed survey for treatment.

The loons nest has been moved on shore and evaluated; we plan on rebuilding a modified version this spring.

**Lake Draw Down Update:** (Mar. 18<sup>th</sup>, 2019) – All stop logs in place; watching and waiting for the water to breach the top stop logs, which should happen with this latest meltdown. Bottom two sets of stop logs were heavily covered with zebra mussels; all stop logs are now clean. There are some zebra mussels on the dam itself, but consulted with Spicer Engineering and DEQ, and both stated we did not have to hire a diver to clean the dam unless we are having issues---all parts of dam are working well. Paperwork in process to renew our draw down permit. Bob would like to thank Dave, Bill, and Dale for their support this year!!!

**Maintenance Corner:** We need volunteers for cutting the lawn at the clubhouse; it seems to work best if we have 2 volunteers per cut, one using a lawn tractor and the other using a push mower. Please call Dave Andrusiak at 248-474-2096, if you are able to help out. Thank You.
