Hi everybody,

Let me take a minute to update you on what is happening with your club as of right now.

First of all, let me thank you for your support as the three proposals presented to you all passed overwhelmingly!!!!

So far, we have sold 342 raffle tickets and the Early Bird drawing was held last Sunday with Paityn Martin drawing the winning ticket...yes, the four of us were wearing masks!!! Congrats to Jerry Forrester who won the \$50 and thanks to Jerry for donating it back to support our BLU LLC fund.

Blair informed the Board that Restorative Lake Sciences has tentatively scheduled our lake survey for 6/16/2020. We will keep you posted.

We are hopeful that we can have the Boat Parade, the Pontoon Poker Run, the Subdivision Garage Sale and the Golf Outing as scheduled. They probably won't look the same as last year, but we would really like to keep these traditions going. The event Chairs are working on tentative plans now. Lastly, regarding our Bottom Land initiative, we have received \$2275 from 17 people which is a little over 13% of what we need to pay off our land contract with BLU LLC.
